The Czech Table Tennis Association (CTTA) has the pleasure to invite International Umpires (IU) to officiate at the forthcoming

ITTF Fa20 Czech Para Open 2022 to be held in Ostrava (CZE) 23-25. 6. 2022

We are pleased to invite 40 International Umpires (IU) to officiate at this event. It is an open invitation therefore not all nominations may be accepted. Associations are requested to nominate a maximum of 6 IUs. The attached „**Nomination form**“ is to be used by associations and sent back by e-mail to tomas.malik@ping-pong.cz latest **15th May**. Receiving of all nominations will be confirmed.

Selection will be done latest **30th May** and umpires will be informed immediately. Selected umpires may not be replaced without prior authorization of the chairman of URC CTTA.

Organizer offer free hospitality in a double room starting from **22th June** dinner, until **26^h June** breakfast.

Each umpire will receive according [Directives for Match Officials at World Title](#) 30 USD or the equivalent for each day of the competition.

Visa:

Should your nominated umpire need a visa, please send us the relevant details when submitting your nomination (full name as in passport, date of birth, place of birth, passport number, date of expiry of passport). We will issue an invitation letter for your umpire. Please note that all costs associated with the visa application are for your or the umpire's cost. Please note that the consulate will issue visas in its sole discretion.
